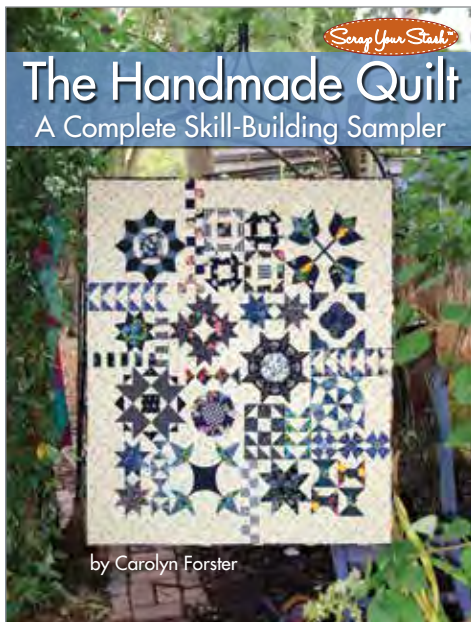

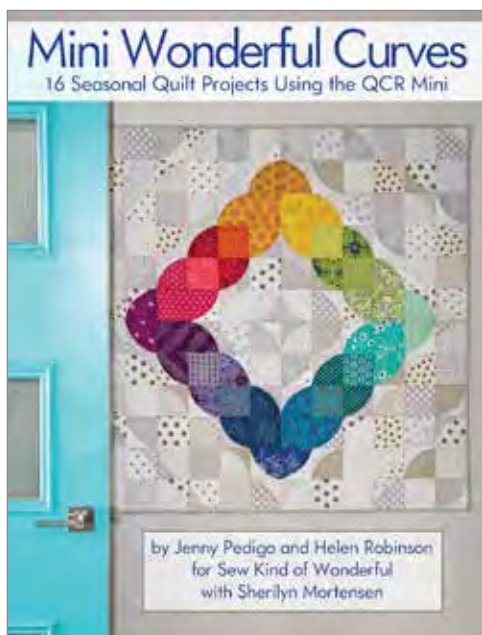

About the authors

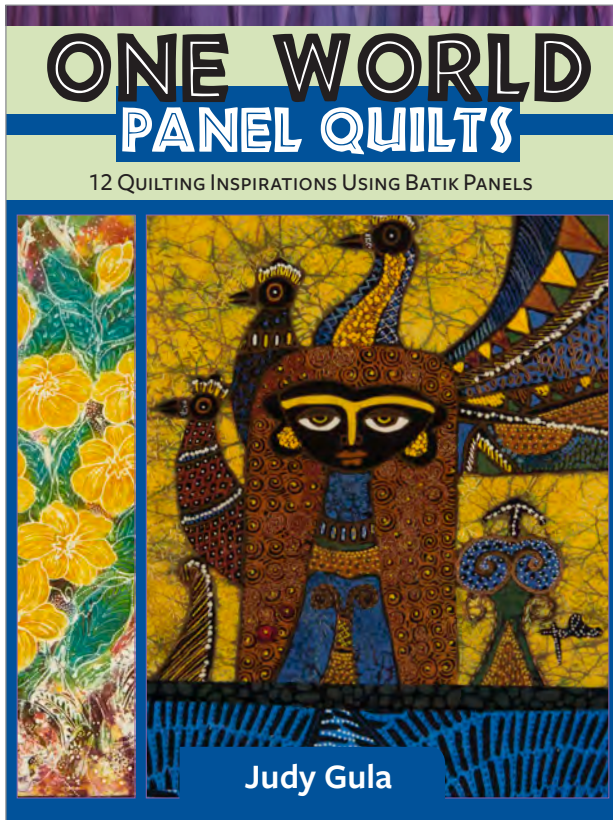
Sew Kind of Wonderful is the brainchild of three sisters who share a passion for quilt design and making beautiful quilt projects.

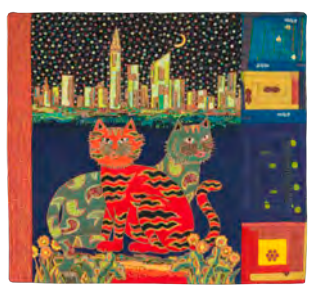

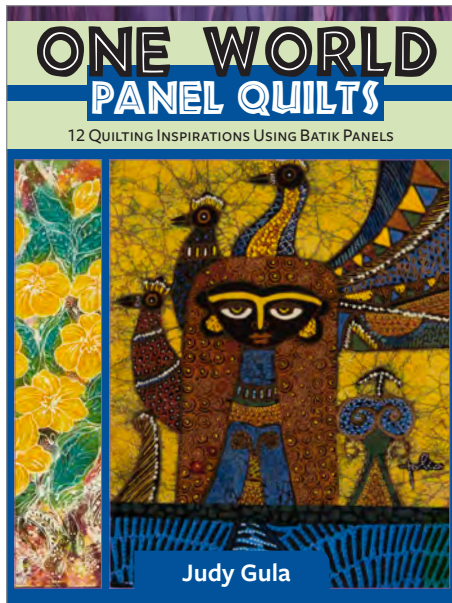

In her new book, *One World Panel Quilts*, Judy Gula takes you on a beautiful journey around the world with bold, graphic and joyous art quilt projects using batik panels created by Indonesian artisans. The handcrafted batiks by leading textile artists in Indonesia can be used to create both traditional and art quilts, home décor, and more.

Readers can explore many creative possibilities working with fabric panels with this book as their creative guide. The book shows how to use the panels in traditional quilt settings, or turn them into works of art with the addition of embellishment.

The creative journey begins with an introduction to Judy's design process, and then moves on to some quick-and-easy projects. As the reader advances through the dozen projects in the book, more step-by-step techniques are covered, including cutting up the panels, enhancing with embellishment, and adding pieced blocks.

One World Panel Quilts is Judy's first book.



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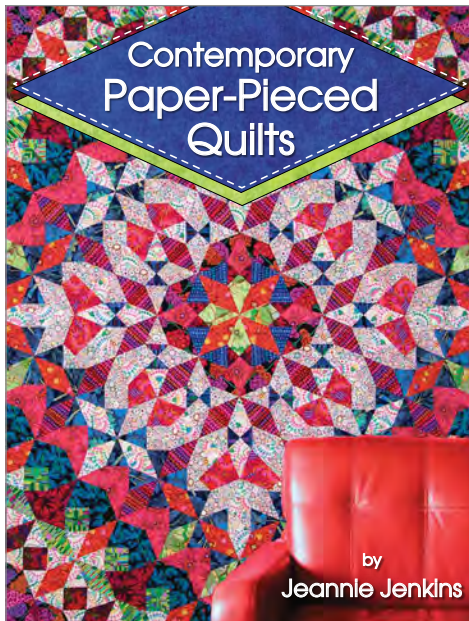

Jeannie Jenkins is a professional quilt designer, teacher, former quilt shop manager, and longarm quilter from Toronto, Ontario.

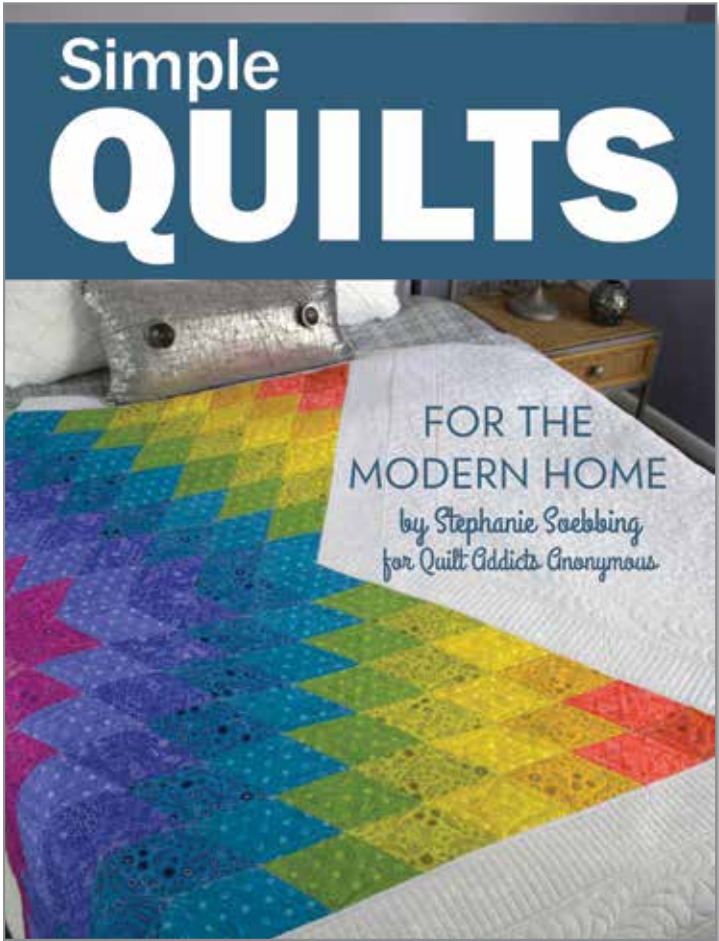
